A. <u>Safe School Technology</u>

Recommendation: Dr. Killion recommended the Board of School Trustees approve the authorization of the superintendent to pursue funding by way of grants for the ASR Alert system and upon funding begin the contract process of the system.

Dr. Killion reported a meeting was held on May 23, 2019 at the intermediate school those in attendance included, Chief Troy Harris, school safety officers, safety committee, board executive members, and school administrators. During the safety meeting, a demonstration of the ASR Alert system (active shooter response technology system) was provided. The system is an instantaneous communication system between the police department and WLCSC. The system was unanimously agreed upon during the demonstration. Although the cost is \$185,000, the superintendent will pursue safety grants to assist with the purchase.
