Braille Tales

Early reading develops braille awareness skills and an enthusiasm for literacy in the hearts of young children. That's why APH offers free print/braille books for preschoolers who are blind or visually impaired.

If you live in the United States and have a preschooler who is blind (5 years of age or younger) we will send you six free print/braille books per year. Braille Tales books allow children to become interested in braille from a young age, encouraging them to be lifelong braille readers. We also send Braille Tales to adults who are blind and want to read to their preschoolers.

APH has partnered with the Dolly Parton Imagination Library which offers free books to children across the country. Through a partnership with APH, 6 of those same books are chosen each year to be our Braille Tales books. Braille labels are added to each book, bringing the whole family together by allowing you to read braille or print.





What is the Core and Expanded Core Curriculum?

Core Curriculum

Educators define core curriculum as the knowledge and skills a student should learn by high school graduation. This foundation, for almost all learning, is generally related to academic subjects.

Expanded Core Curriculum

The American Printing House for the Blind, and most professionals in the field, firmly believe that students who have a visual impairment need an expanded core curriculum that encompasses additional areas of learning. Experiences and concepts casually and incidentally learned by sighted students must be systematically and sequentially taught to students with a visual impairment.

Dr. Philip Hatlen (1934–2016) authored the introductory copy at the beginning of each of the Expanded Core Curriculum sections in this catalog. Dr. Hatlen's numerous accomplishments included the original development of the Expanded Core Curriculum. Dr. Hatlen had many connections at APH, including acting as Ex Officio Trustee and our Executive in Residence. Children and adults with both visual impairments and multiple disabilities are diverse in their strengths and interests. APH has long embraced inclusive strategies in product development, resulting in many products appropriate for individuals who have visual and/or aural impairments, and other disabilities.

APH Intervention Continuum – Three Sequential Kits

APH recommends that learners use the following three products sequentially:

Sensory Learning Kit (SLK) — page 34

This Kit is an extensive set of sensory items, assessments, and written materials that help the most significantly challenged learners increase their curiosity and attention while developing specific skills.

SAM: Symbols and Meaning — page 95

A kit for learners with visual and multiple impairments, and pre-school children with visual impairments who are beginning to use symbols.

Tactile Connections: Symbols for Communication — page 95

This kit helps learning partners create a tactile card communication system for learners who lack a formal means of communication. The versatility of the kit allows for symbolic skill expansion from concrete to more abstract, and from single-word to multi-word communications.

Child-guided Strategies: The Van Dijk Approach to Assessment — page 16 An easy-to-use guidebook with an accompanying DVD or flash drive that follows the assessment of a baby, a young child, and a teenager.

Expandable Calendar Boxes — page 96

IBBY is a non-profit organization representing an international network of people committed to bringing books and children together. As the reader journeys across the page, sliding a small token along a path, fingers encounter tactile and audible features, such as waving grass, a silken stream, a squishy marsh, trunks of trees, and slippery "snow." Feeling inside the cave reveals a furry face with big eyes, a soft nose, and sharp teeth!

Traditional braille consists of six dots per cell, but six dots can only represent 64 unique patterns. Braille overcomes this limitation by letting two or more cells represent a single character. Preceding the symbol for a letter, for example, with a dot six makes that letter capital.

Shipping Methods

Shipping within the U.S.

Most items ordered by or for people who are visually impaired will be shipped via Free Matter for the Blind, a free service provided by USPS. Please allow up to 2 weeks shipping time for items sent via Free Matter for the Blind. Customers needing a faster shipping option can contact Customer Service via phone, email, fax, or mail for a freight quote. Customers will be responsible for any upgraded shipping costs.

Note: When indicated, select items cannot be shipped via Free Matter and will require paid shipping.

Shipping Outside of the U.S.

Some items ordered by or for people who are visually impaired can be shipped to most overseas destinations via Free Matter for the Blind (surface mail). The customer is responsible for the shipping cost of all other items requiring paid freight. Please contact Customer Service via phone, email, fax, or mail for a freight estimate. APH recommends shipment by Priority Mail International Airmail, as surface mail is much slower.

All export and/or import duties, brokerage fees, etc. are paid by the customer. Please check with your customs broker to make arrangements in advance.


Repair Warranty

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



Federal Quota Funds Could Help Purchase APH Materials For Your Students

The federal Act to Promote the Education of the Blind provides funds for accessible educational materials for eligible students who meet the definition of blindness. An annual registration of eligible students determines a per capita amount of money specifically designated for the purchase of educational materials produced by the American Printing House for the Blind (APH). **These funds are credited to Federal Quota accounts** maintained and administered by APH and its Ex Officio Trustees throughout the United States and Outlying Areas.

Who is Eligible?

While there is no chronological age limit for eligibility, for students to be eligible to participate in the Federal Quota Program, they MUST fulfill the following requirements:

- Meet the definition of blindness (MDB) a central visual acuity of 20/200 or less (using a Snellen chart or an acuity determined in Snellen equivalents) in the better eye with the best correction or a peripheral field of vision no greater than 20 degrees or function at the definition of blindness (FDB)—when visual function meets the definition of blindness as determined by an eye care specialist (ophthalmologist or optometrist) or other medical doctor such as a neurologist. Students in this category manifest unique visual characteristics often found in conditions referred to as neurological, cortical, or cerebral visual impairment (e.g., brain injury or dysfunction).
- Be enrolled in a formally organized public or private, nonprofit educational program of less than college level. (Adult students previously enrolled in college level programs, however, ARE eligible.)
- Infants, preschool, and school-aged students must be enrolled with the registering school or agency on the first Monday in January.
- Adult students must be registered for at least 12 weeks for a minimum of 20 hours per week of
 documented instruction of less than college level, during the preceding calendar year (twelve weeks do
 not have to be consecutive). Social and leisure programs do not qualify as instruction; however, student
 practice to develop skills can be included in instructional hours.
- As of the 2018 census, each infant, preschool, or school-aged student must have a signed parent permission form to be registered in the Federal Quota Program, as well as adults with a guardian.

Who are the Ex Officio Trustees?

For each residential school for the blind, state department of education, or agency for the blind that participates in the Federal Quota Program, an Ex Officio Trustee of the American Printing House for the Blind must be designated. Each Ex Officio Trustee is entrusted with the administration of the Federal Quota Program within his or her system.


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
