PSAT Date for LMHS: (Sign-Up is currently taking place).

The date of the PSAT administered for Linn-Mar High School students is on **Tuesday, January 26, 2021**. The PSAT will be taken at the Doubletree Conference Center in downtown Cedar Rapids. Busses will load at Door #9 at 8:45 a.m. and return from the Doubletree at 1:00 p.m. The exam will begin at 9:30 a.m. at the Doubletree Conference Center.

Sign-up for 11th and interested 10th and 9th Grade students is now open and has been extended through December 18. Payment is made on the parent/guardian Powerschool account under "Purchases and Payments". By making payment your child will be registered for the PSAT. The cost to the student for the exam, payable at sign-up, is \$17. Contact the Cashier's Office at 447-3101 or jdayton@linnmar.k12.ia.us for any payment questions. Only 11th Grade students are eligible for National Merit Scholarships and Recognition. Again, the deadline for PSAT payment is now December 18.
