VACCINE CLINIC FOR STUDENTS ON MAY 19 AT LRC:

Linn-Mar will again partner with Unity Point to offer a vaccine clinic tomorrow, Wednesday, May 19, for interested students in grades 7th-12th grade. A 2nd clinic will be offered on June 8th and 9th for students to receive the 2nd dose.

Class of 2021 Last Day of School is Wednesday, May 26:

The last day of classes for the LMHS Class of 2021 will be Wednesday, May 26. Graduation Rehearsal (Mandatory) will begin at 1:00 p.m. sharp in the LM Main Gym. Seniors will be officially dismissed from high school following a successful rehearsal session. Weather permitting, we are planning to take the Senior Class Picture in '2021' formation at 12:05 p.m. on May 26, at LM Stadium. Following the Class Picture, we plan to have hot dogs, chips, etc. for a Senior Class Cookout at the stadium prior to Graduation Rehearsal at 1:00 p.m.
