Process for Opting to Come to School Every Day at Any Time During 4th Quarter:

Students wishing to start Every Day attendance for 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter may do so by having parents contact either the 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Grades Office (447-4043, 447-3050), 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades Office (447-3070, 447-3046), or the Main Office (447-3040) at any time during 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter that a student wishes to start attending Every Day, they may do so by having parents let the 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Grades Office, 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades Office, or the Main Office know by 1:00 p.m. the day prior to returning Every Day so that teachers can be made aware and will be expecting your student.

The process for students wishing to go to Online-Only has not changed. Parents will need to notify Associate Superintendent Nathan Wear (<u>Nathan.wear@linnmar.k12.ia.us</u>) for any student to change to Online-Only.
