# Whitetails Unlimited Scholarship

Application must be postmarked no later than March 30th

## Eligibility:

- 1. Students should be graduating seniors with a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent grade point average.
- 2. Students must be pursuing a degree at an accredited institution of higher education.
- 3. Students must support the preservation of the hunting tradition and actively participate in hunting sports. Hunter's education card number is required.
- 4. Students must be involved in school activities.
- 5. Students must demonstrate ability as a leader among his or her peers.
- 6. Students must demonstrate community leadership and/or involvement.
- 7. Students must submit an essay exhibiting dedication to conservation (see part IV for criteria).
- 8. Students must submit a complete application by March 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### Selection Process:

- 1. Students will submit an application to Whitetails Unlimited Committee.
- 2. Two recipients will be chosen.
- 3. Winners may not be notified until their high school awards banquet.
- 4. The winner will be invited to attend the local Whitetails Unlimited Banquet in April to be recognized.

### Disbursement of Funds:

- 1. Each winner will receive \$500 to be used toward college expenses.
- Payment will be mailed to winners address after receiving a copy of their fall college schedule.
   \*Schedule can be mailed to the same address as application.

- 1. Make sure all portions of the application are complete and include all requested enclosures.
- 2. Applicant and school guidance counselor/principal must sign application.
