

# Whitetails Unlimited Scholarship

Application must be postmarked no later than March 30<sup>th</sup>

## Eligibility:

1. Students should be graduating seniors with a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent grade point average.
2. Students must be pursuing a degree at an accredited institution of higher education.
3. Students must support the preservation of the hunting tradition and actively participate in hunting sports. Hunter's education card number is required.
4. Students must be involved in school activities.
5. Students must demonstrate ability as a leader among his or her peers.
6. Students must demonstrate community leadership and/or involvement.
7. Students must submit an essay exhibiting dedication to conservation (see part IV for criteria).
8. Students must submit a complete application by March 30<sup>th</sup>.

## Selection Process:

1. Students will submit an application to Whitetails Unlimited Committee.
2. Two recipients will be chosen.
3. Winners may not be notified until their high school awards banquet.
4. The winner will be invited to attend the local Whitetails Unlimited Banquet in April to be recognized.

## Disbursement of Funds:

1. Each winner will receive \$500 to be used toward college expenses.
2. Payment will be mailed to winners address after receiving a copy of their fall college schedule.  
\*Schedule can be mailed to the same address as application.

## Instructions:

1. Make sure all portions of the application are complete and include all requested enclosures.
2. Applicant and school guidance counselor/principal must sign application.
