# Our grading system:

#### 20% participation and daily assignments

Students will complete daily work in the classroom and on google classroom. They are expected to take notes and ask questions during modeling and then be prepared to work independently with teacher support.

#### 20% Exit tickets

Students will complete exit tickets at the end of most classes to complete a quick check in for understanding. They are graded on effort and use of class strategies.

#### 30% Quizzes and tests

Quizzes will be assigned every week to 10 days to check in on student's use of strategies and class examples. Tests are scheduled at the end of each of our math modules.

## 20% Skills/Intervention Class:

This class supports CORE math class and is graded on class work and participation. **10% Homework:** 

Homework will be assigned every night Monday-Thursday in CORE math class, with no homework given out on Fridays for the weekend. There may be some weeks where the full weekly assignment is handed out on Monday but is not due until Friday. Homework is graded on best effort and reasonable answers using classroom strategies and must be handed in **on time**. Students must attempt all

problems and show all work for credit. Students are responsible for writing all homework assignments in the agenda book <u>each day along with the due date</u>. Unless there has been an excused absence, it is not reasonable for students to ask to make up multiple missing homework assignments or right before grading as it needs to be a reflection of current work.
