Sign up for the **2021 Preliminary SAT (PSAT)** is now open. The PSAT is designed for juniors as a practice test and **is also a qualification for the National Merit Scholarship Program**. Sophomores may also take the test but will need to take the PSAT again as a junior to qualify as a National Merit scholar.
