Exams

All AP Students need to plan to take their exams adhering to the locations, dates and times listed in the table above. All digital exams will be taken at home, MHS will not be hosting digital exams at school.

Additional information for at-home testing

- Each student will need access to a desktop or laptop (mac, windows or a school-issued chromebook).
- The student's computer must have a built-in or attached camera
- The computer can't be shared between students once exam set-up is complete (1-3 days prior to the exam)
- Computers must be able to hold a charge or be plugged in for the duration of the exam.
- Students must have a reliable internet connection, though the testing application has been designed to tolerate disruptions in internet connectivity during the exam
- Approved College Board testing accommodations will be supported in digital exams

Additional information for in-school testing

- Testing will be held in the gym, auxiliary gym and media center, with a minimum of 6-feet spacing between students.
- Masks will be worn at all times during testing.
- Food and drink will not be permitted in the testing room
- Students must arrive to school by 7:30 for morning exams and 11:30AM for afternoon exams
- Busses will NOT be available to take students home after exams or to bring students to school for a PM exam
