Questions & Answers

Who can Attend Summer School?

- ☐ A student who has failed a required course and needs to make that up
- ☐ A student who is interested in taking classes for credit advancement
- ☐ A student who wants to open up their schedule for the following year
- ☐ A student in good academic standing in the 8th - 11th grade with counselor and parent approval

How many credits can I earn?

- ☐ Students can earn one (1) credit (session 1 & 2) upon successful completion of course, final exam and required attendance. Credit will be determined by home school for out-of-district students.

What is the Summer School Schedule?

- ☐ Session I - June 21, 2021-July 6, 2021 (Final Exam July 6, 2021)
- ☐ Session II - July 7, 2021- July 21, 2021 (Final Exam July 21, 2021)

What time does the class begin and end?

- Classes begin at 8:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

What is the Tuition?

- ☐ Novi High School Student \$305 per class (.5 credit)
- ☐ Out-of-district Students \$335 per class (.5 credit)

What is the Attendance/Credit Policy

- ☐ Students are **REQUIRED** to attend the entire 22-day session. **No exceptions.**
- ☐ Students whose vacation and/or camp schedule interfere with the summer school schedule should not enroll.
- ☐ Attendance violation will result in being dropped from the class, no refund, and loss of credit.

What is the Code of Conduct?

- ☐ The Novi Community Schools code of Conduct will be followed by all summer school students.
- ☐ Summer School is a closed campus program.
- ☐ No visitors are permitted on school property except for district employees.
- ☐ Students will not be permitted to stay in their cars during school hours and smoking is not permitted on school property.

What about Lunch?

- ☐ Students may bring lunch to school. Snacks and beverages are available for purchase.

When is Registration?

- ☐ Courses will be available for registration Online at www.novi.k12.mi.us/communityed/summer-school
- ☐ All students will be required to complete a 2021 Summer High School Credit Verification form.

What happens if I drop before classes start?

- ☐ Classes run based on enrollment numbers, last minute cancellations affect staffing and program format. There is a \$75 cancellation fee for classes that are cancelled within 72 hours of course start date.
- ☐ There will be a \$10 class transfer fee for students requesting to change a class.

What about Refunds once Summer School Starts?

- ☐ All drops must be completed on or before the 5th day of class at a pro-rated rate: Drops on the 6th day will result in **NO REFUND**, and an “E” grade will be issued. There will be a **5%** processing fee on all refunds.
