Criteria for Consideration for the 2021 Homecoming Court:

Please read this information carefully. Be sure your parent(s) or guardian(s) understand these rules and criteria as we will not make exceptions for any student for any reason.

To be considered for the court EACH CANDIDATE MUST:

- 1. Be a current student at Independence High School.
- 2. Have paid current class dues (\$10) and attach proof of purchase. (online receipt) Independence High online payments
- 3. Have a minimum 2.5 GPA, unweighted
- 4. Be currently passing all courses for the Fall 2021 semester AND currently passing all enrolled classes
- 5. Be in good disciplinary standing during the 2020-2021 school year
- 6. Be able to attend rehearsals and zoom meetings. If there is a need to be absent, the applicant must inform Ms. Hamrick at least one week prior in email and gain approval for the absence.
- 7. Turn in completed completed PAPER applications by Friday, September 24, 2021 by 2:30pm. You will only turn in pages 3, 4, receipt from dues, and a colored picture
- 8. Understand that NO EXTENSIONS for ANYONE for ANY reason will be granted

How to Run for Homecoming Court

- 1. All applications must include:
 - a. A colored picture submitted with the application. The picture should include ONLY the applicant.
 - b. Adhere to the <u>Pledge of Responsibility</u>
 - i. Include a student signature
 - ii. Include a parent/guardian signature
 - iii. Adhere to campaigning rules
- 2. Please only submit the actual application portion. Be sure to include a receipt of paid dues and a colored picture.

Election

All applications will be reviewed. As long as all applicants have met all the criteria required, applicants will be listed on the ballot under the appropriate position. Any violation of these guidelines will result in the applicant's removal from the ballot. The Homecoming nominees will be announced during SEL on Tuesday, September 28. Please understand, just because you submit an application, does not guarantee being nominated. The Homecoming Court will voted on during SEL on Tuesday, October 6 during SEL. The final Homecoming court will **be announced on Wednesday, October 6.** This means that the Freshman, Sophomore, Junior Duchesses and Senior Princesses will be announced. The Queen, a senior, will be announced at half time during the Homecoming Football game on Friday, October 15.
