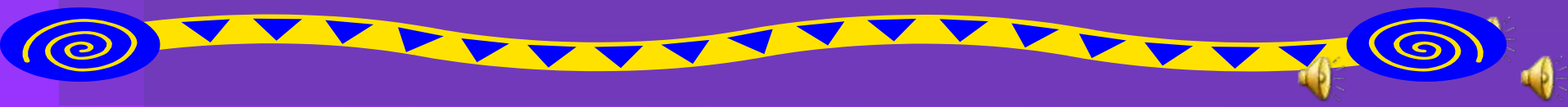

For Your Information

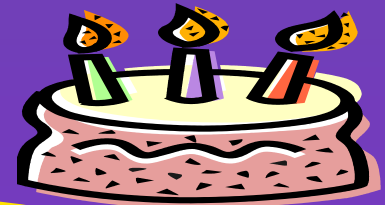
- ☉ Snacktime is offered each day. Due to allergies, I do not provide snack if your child does not bring one into school.

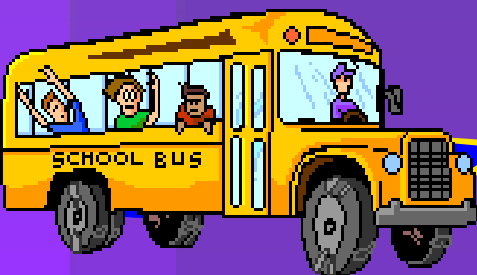

More Information.....

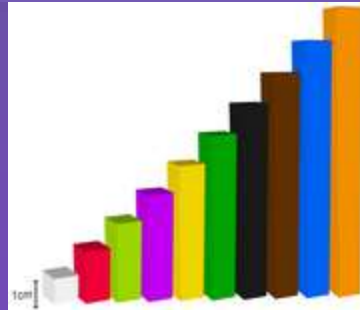
