

The **All Aboard Summer School Program** is offered by the Altoona School District for incoming <u>Kindergarten through 8th grade</u> students. Children that live within the Altoona School District's limits, or are currently open enrolled, are eligible to participate.

We have an Enrichment K-4 program held at Altoona Elementary **and** an Enrichment 5-8 program held at Altoona Middle School.

Enrichment K-4 and 5th -8th grades

- <u>Session 1</u>, July 6-July 22
- Session 2, July 26- August 12

<u>Please note that the program runs Monday-Thursday 8:30-1:00pm.</u>

There is no charge for Altoona School District students to attend, however, donations for class supplies are accepted and appreciated. Checks can be made out to the Altoona School District and dropped off at the Altoona Elementary office.

Registration begins <u>April 27th at 3:00 pm for Enrichment K-4 and April 28th at</u> <u>3:00 pm for Enrichment 5-8</u>. The registration deadline for both sessions is Friday, May 29th (or when classes are full).

*Remedial classes are by invitation. Classroom teachers will send home a letter if your child was identified as a student that would benefit from remediation mid-April. *

TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD:

1.Log in to your Family Access account.

2.You will click on the "**ARENA SCHEDULING**" button on the left side of your screen 3.If you have multiple children, you will need to select a child to register.

4.Add the classes your child wishes to attend. Please make sure you look at the term you are selecting. ST1 is the first session (July 6-July 22) and ST2 is the second session (July 26-August 12). If your child will be attending both sessions, you will schedule both sessions at this time.
5.You may View/Print your child's schedule at any time to verify that you have selected the

correct classes prior to clicking SUBMIT.

6.After verifying your choices, click the **SUBMIT** button.

7.Next you will click on the "**ONLINE FORMS**" button on the left side of your screen right above the Arena Scheduling button. This link will bring you to the RAIL Permission & Bus form. **Your class** requests will not be approved until this form is completed.

8.You will complete the form and click on the Complete Step 1 and move to Step 2 button at the bottom of the form.____

9.Next you will click the **SUBMIT** button and you are all done!

10. To register another child, you will click on your child's name at the top of the screen and repeat steps 1 - 9.

No more rainy-day boredom! In this class, we will take part in a wide variety of engaging activities that will keep students on their toes and explore indoors and outdoors. Students will have the opportunity to play large group games, team building activities, and outdoor adventures.

Canine Companion (1st/2nd, 3rd/4th)

<u>All Aboard Summer School Program</u> <u>Enrichment 5th-8th grade 2021</u> <u>Class Descriptions</u>

Session 1: July 6-July 22

Card Sharks (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

A RAIL favorite! In this class you will learn card games you can play by yourself, games you can play with friends, and games you can play at your next family game night! Along with some fun games, there will be some card building and magic sprinkled in!

Cardboard Box Arcade (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Inspired by "Cain's Arcade: A boy's cardboard arcade that inspired the world". You will be challenged to design an arcade game made from recycled materials. On the last day, we will invite others to play our games.

Computer Fun (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Do you like to be creative? Do you like using computers? In Computer Fun you will be able to make cards, pictures, and many other projects to take home. You will be able to show your creative side while learning how to use the computer.

Amazing Earth & Beyond (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This project-based learning class will allow students to use creative thinking to explore the wonders of the earth, oceans, planets and beyond. Hands on projects will include building volcanoes, rockets, Cartesian divers and more.

Just Relax (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This class will teach kids different ways to relieve stress. Puzzles, yoga, exercise, coloring and making stress relieving tools are a few examples of activities that will help us learn to Just Relax!

Perfect Puzzles (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

If puzzles are your thing, this is the PERFECT class for you! You will have opportunities to stretch your mind by working on a variety of different puzzles: word search, crossword, sudoku, table top, tangrams, and more!

Ugly Dolls (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Ugly dolls? Yes! In this class, you will make a pattern of a favorite character, transfer it to felt, stitch it up, and stuff it. You will learn a few stitches and how to sew on a button too. Bring your imagination!

Photoshop Fun (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Have fun exploring all the cool features of Adobe Photoshop to create photographic masterpieces. Bring your creativity, and a little sense of humor too!

Moving West (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This class will feature a life size, interactive, role playing of the Oregon Trail. Students will work in a "wagon train" to solve problems and scenarios to help them move throughout the board and reach their destination. This class promotes teamwork and problem-solving skills to help them along the way while incorporating fun and interactive methods.

Outdoor Inquiry (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Spend your days outside discovering the wonders of nature around you! This class will give students the opportunity to observe, contemplate, and come to conclusions about the world around them as they spend time in one of the best classrooms: the great outdoors. Students will learn about ecosystems, sound pollution, and weather patterns.

Outdoor Adventures $(5^{th}/6^{th}, 7^{th}/8^{th})$ <u>**This is a 3 hour class</u> (8:30-11:30), open to the first 30 students registered.

The Outdoor Adventures class is designed to get students interested and engaged in the great outdoors while incorporating science and active learning. Students will need to have a bicycle that is in working order. Students will be expected to be able to bike up to 10 miles at a comfortable pace. All students must bring a properly fitted bike helmet to class.

Backyard Bonanza (5th/6th, 7th/8th) Tired of sitting inside watching TV or playing video games? This is the perfect class for you! The outdoors and our backyards are full of entertaining possibilities. Students will learn a variety of yard games such as bean bags, Ladder and Frisbee golf, Kubb, Bocce, washers, horseshoes and Disc Dunk. We will also explore power walking, orienteering, building debris huts and gardening.

Team Building (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This is a very active class where you will learn how to work together and show good sportsmanship as we play a variety of indoor & outdoor sports and team activities.

Create-a-Civilization (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Students will create their own unique civilization. To accomplish this, they will create a flag, currency, government, maps, and a national anthem. The students will also look at natural resources and practice world trade with other civilizations in the class. This class will allow students to showcase their creativity while learning about key concepts important in social studies. The use of technology and hands on instruction will allow a variety of learners to thrive in the class atmosphere.

Book Making (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This class will bring out the author and illustrator in you. Participants will create and publish their very own book.

Creative Journaling (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Board Games Galore (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Learn strategies and rules of classic board games and learn some new ones too! Bring your good sportsmanship and positive attitude for an hour of fun game-playing techniques!

Team Building (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

This is not a repeat of the first session. This is a very active class where you will learn how to work together and show good sportsmanship as we play a variety of indoor & outdoor sports and team activities.

Art on the Bus $(5^{th}/6^{th}, 7^{th}/8^{th})$

Art on the Bus is a public art project in collaboration between Eau Claire Transit and area public schools. In this class, you will create artwork for bus #525. This art Exhibition will be on the bus for one year! This will be the 8th year RAILS is participating!

Yarn Bombs (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Yarn Bomb? What is Yarn Bombing? It is the art activity of covering an everyday object with yarn. In this cool class, you will learn to crochet, braid on a circle loom, finger knit, make ojo's de dios weavings, and wrap objects. Then, with our creations, we will cover a piece of playground equipment, transforming it from ordinary to extraordinary!

Construction Club (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

Put your engineering skills to the test with this hands-on class! You will use many modes of building including some of your favorites...Legos and Lincoln Logs.

Minecraft Projects (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

What is the volume of a swimming pool? What is the area of a house? What do cities need to meet the needs of the people that live there? These are all things we will answer by creating in Minecraft. Students will complete different projects and will often need to use math and even social studies to plan their design.

Summer Olympics and Team Building (5th/6th, 7th/8th)

In honor of this year's summer Olympics you will learn a variety of team building games. You will work as a team, demonstrate good sportsmanship, and compete to be the gold medal winner.

Origami/Paper Folding/Paper Airplane

Refine your artistic and engineering abilities in this class. You will learn a variety of paper folder techniques. Additionally, you will create a paper airplane design and test its ability to fly.
