Those responses may often come from the board president, not as a means of silencing other voices and opinions, but rather to streamline the conversations for the sake of efficiency and to avoid confusion. An effective board works together as a team in the best interest of the schools. Individual members have unique voices and skill sets, we were each elected by the community to conduct the business of the school board. but no one of us has any importance over another or individual authority as a single board member. Our only authority comes when we assemble together in meetings of the board held in public.

Throughout the United States school boards, including this one, have increasingly been subjected to personal insults, threats and a steady stream of destructive communication. While we all have children ourselves and understand how emotional some of these issues can be, our community can expect professional communication from us and we would ask the same from our community. We believe we can do better in West Lafayette and we know, with certainty, that our students deserve better.
