Eastside High Parking Application Process and Procedures

- Parking permits will be sold to 10th 12th graders based on availability.
 - Ninth graders are not allowed to purchase parking permits and therefore cannot drive to school.
- Students must have a current driver's license to complete the application. Restricted licenses are permitted.
- All outstanding debt must be paid.
 - Debt notifications were emailed to your school email address the first week of June.
 - Debt notifications did not include textbook debts or fines. Contact the front office at 355-2801 if you are unsure if you have textbook debt or fines.
 - The debt must be paid in the front office by cash or check before submitting the online application.
- The parking fee is \$50. Payment is non-refundable.
- Parking spots will be assigned using a computer-generated lottery system on August 3rd.
 - o Top 10 (Seniors) will have spots #1-10.
 - The remaining seniors will be assigned based on their lottery results starting with spot #11.
 - After seniors go through the lottery system, underclassmen will go through the lottery system for the remaining spots.

- Parking passes will be distributed to students on their assigned orientation date/time. Orientation dates/times will be posted on the
 website at a later date.
- Once 405 parking applications have been completed (with payment), the online application will be taken off the school webpage
 and a waiting list will be created. If this happens, please email mdrango@greenville.k12.sc.us to be added to the waiting list.
- If the above requirements are not met and the steps below are not done correctly, your application will be disqualified.

Application Process

- Step 1: Complete the 2022 parking application. Students must be signed into their school google account to complete the application.
 - Students must upload their valid driver's license (restricted licenses are permitted), valid vehicle registration, and current vehicle insurance card.
 - Vehicle registration and insurance uploaded <u>must not</u> be expired when the application is submitted.
 - The VIN number on the vehicle registration and insurance card <u>must</u> match.
 - Starting in the 2023-2024 school year, the current "Senior Lot" will first be open to Seniors who have achieved College or Career Readiness. Once all Seniors that have achieved College or Career Readiness have been assigned a spot, the remaining parking spots in the student parking are assigned through a lottery system.
