Job Shadow Opportunities through Workplace Learning Connection

Students in grades 10-12 have the opportunity to participate in job shadows provided by Workplace Learning Connection. Job shadows are a short, one-day experience that allows students to see what a career might look like at a local employer. Students are encouraged to participate in this FREE experience throughout high school to ensure they adequately plan for a future career. Research has shown that participation in work-based learning opportunities can increase enrollment postsecondary training and postsecondary employment by as much as 10%! Then go to www.workplacelearningconnections.com to create an account (or sign in to an existing account) to complete the applications. Students should be prepared to include a parent email address for parent approval. Both the student application and online parent approval are required before school counselors will approve the application. Parent approval emails may end up in "junk" or "spam" and should arrive soon after student applications are submitted.
