Depression Screening Available the Week of February 13

The teen years, not even factoring in the pandemic, are marked by a rollercoaster ride of emotions – difficult for teens, their parents, and educators. Linn Mar Counselors will be offering Depression Screening the week of February 13 for those who have a consent form with parental approval. They are focusing on 9th and 10th grades for screenings, however, 11th and 12th students will be screened upon parent request. This tool cannot provide a diagnosis of depression, but it does give an indication of whether a young person should be referred for evaluation by a mental health professional.
