For the presale, it is true that anyone can order pictures. However, the pictures are sent to the school and will go home with the students. So, there is not a possibility of a random stranger ending up with pictures of your students.

The pictures are available to view in the after sale, and they will also be shipped to home addresses. However, the only way to log into the after sale is with the student ID number. This number is provided to the parents when the pictures are sent home. If the student did not order pictures, they will receive a small preview of the picture, along with the web address and student ID number.

Pictures are not available to the general public. One of our highest priorities is the safety of your students. We hope this clarifies your concerns.
