What to BRING

- A photo ID (KHS Student ID or Driver's License)
- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for exam booklet covers and free-response sections.
- A calculator & extra batteries for Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics and Statistics exam. To ensure your calculator meets College Board guidelines, check with your AP teacher or the <u>College Board Website</u>.

What NOT to Bring

- Cell phones, Smart Watches and other electronic devices are NOT PERMITTED IN THE TESTING ROOMS
- Books, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, notebooks, or a back pack
- Rulers (only allowed for Physics exam) or other classroom equipment
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets)
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Food or drink (A light snack will be provided for you during the break.)
- Clothing with subject-related information

AP Score Information. Scores are released electronically in July. You will check your scores on your College Board account at apscore.org or through My AP. Before June 20, sign in to My AP to indicate which college or university you'd like to receive your free score report.
