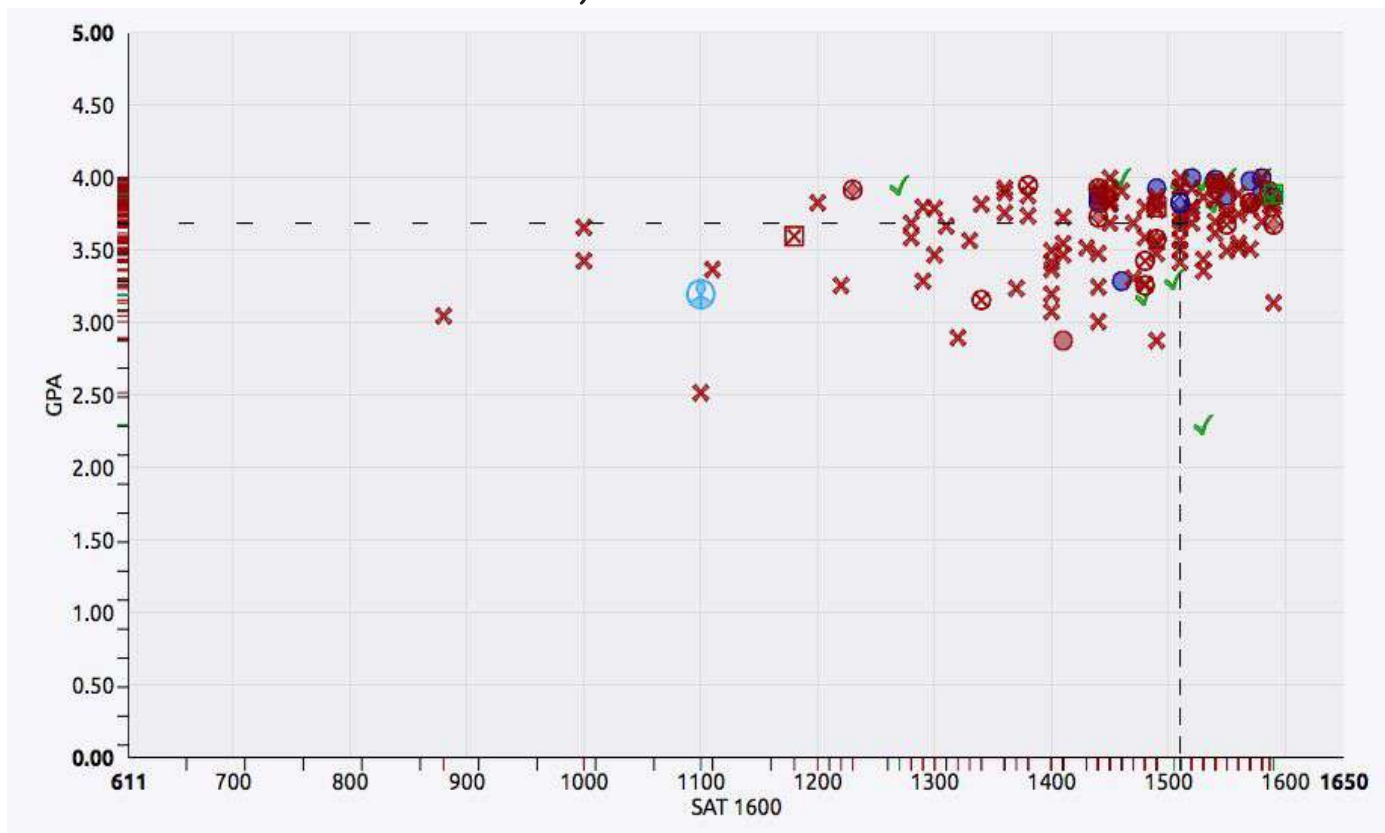




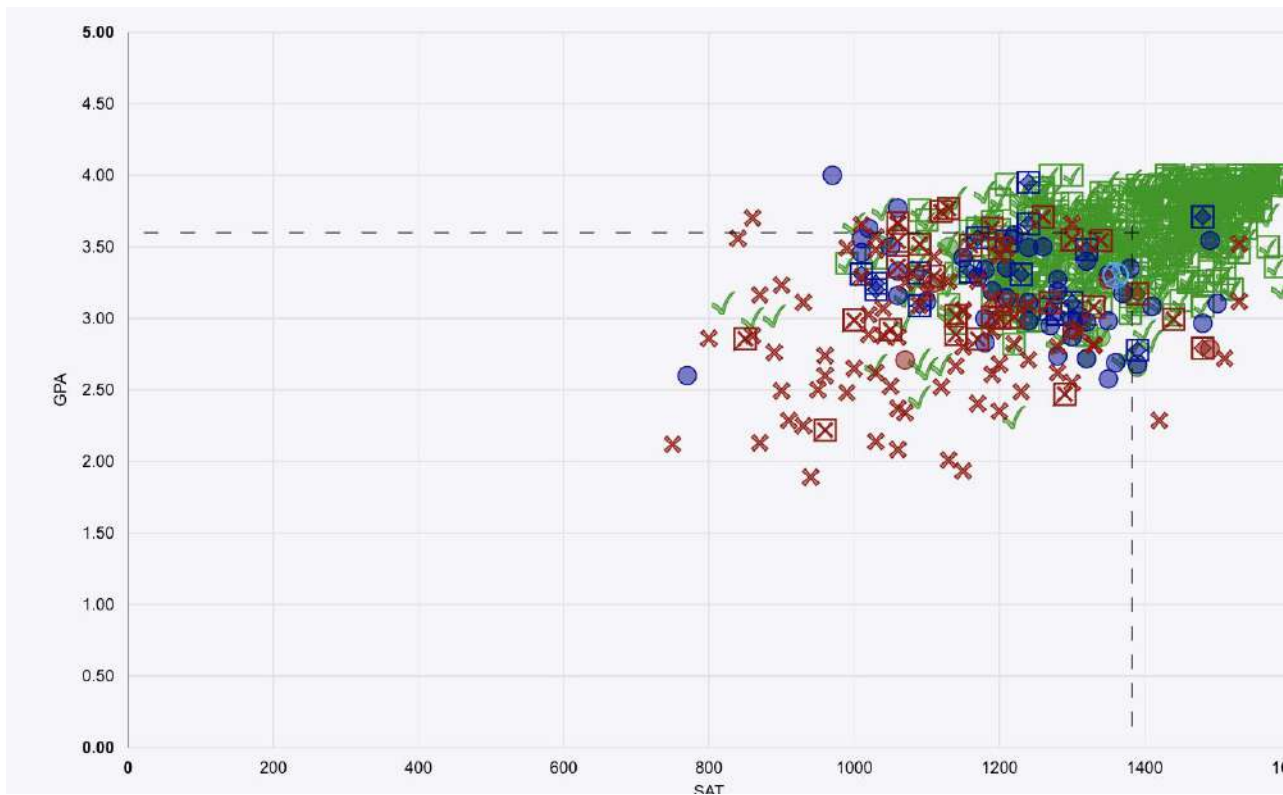
# NAVIANCE GRAPH: SAFETY, MATCH OR REACH?



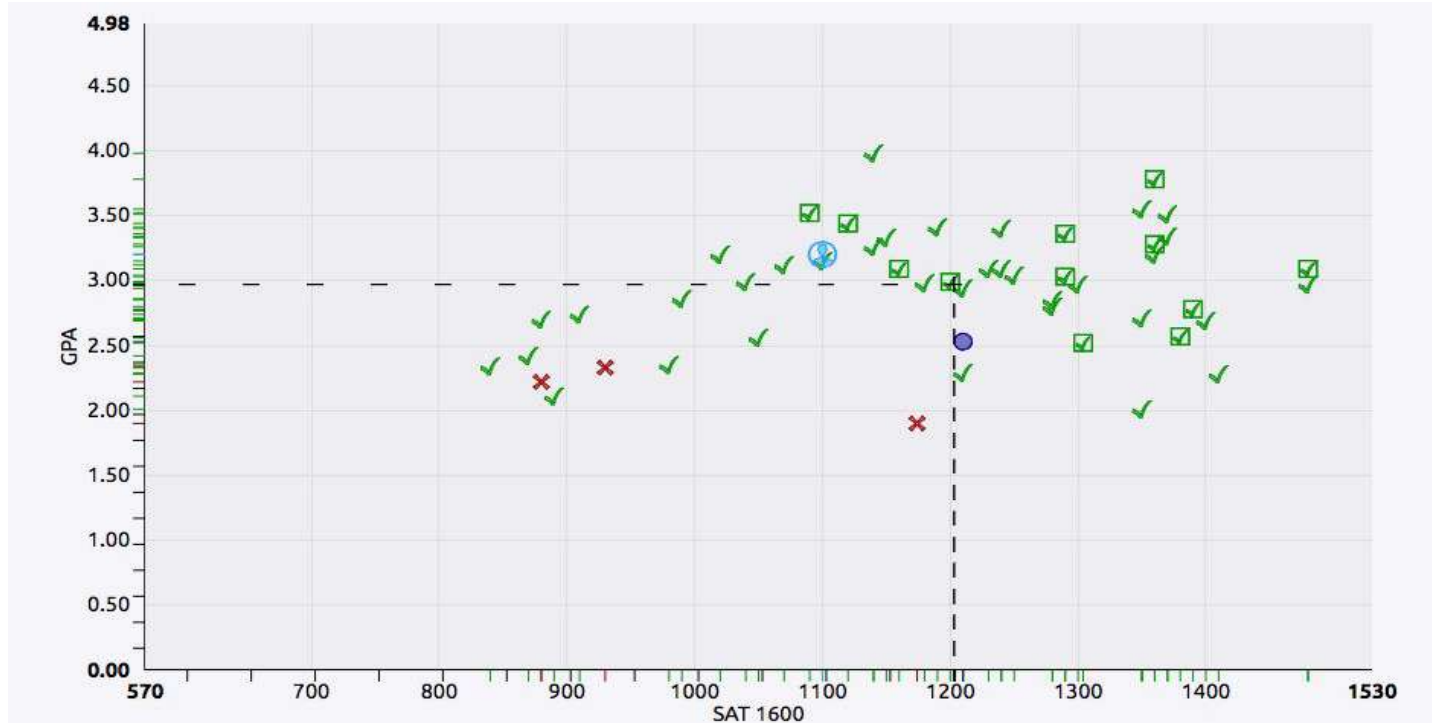

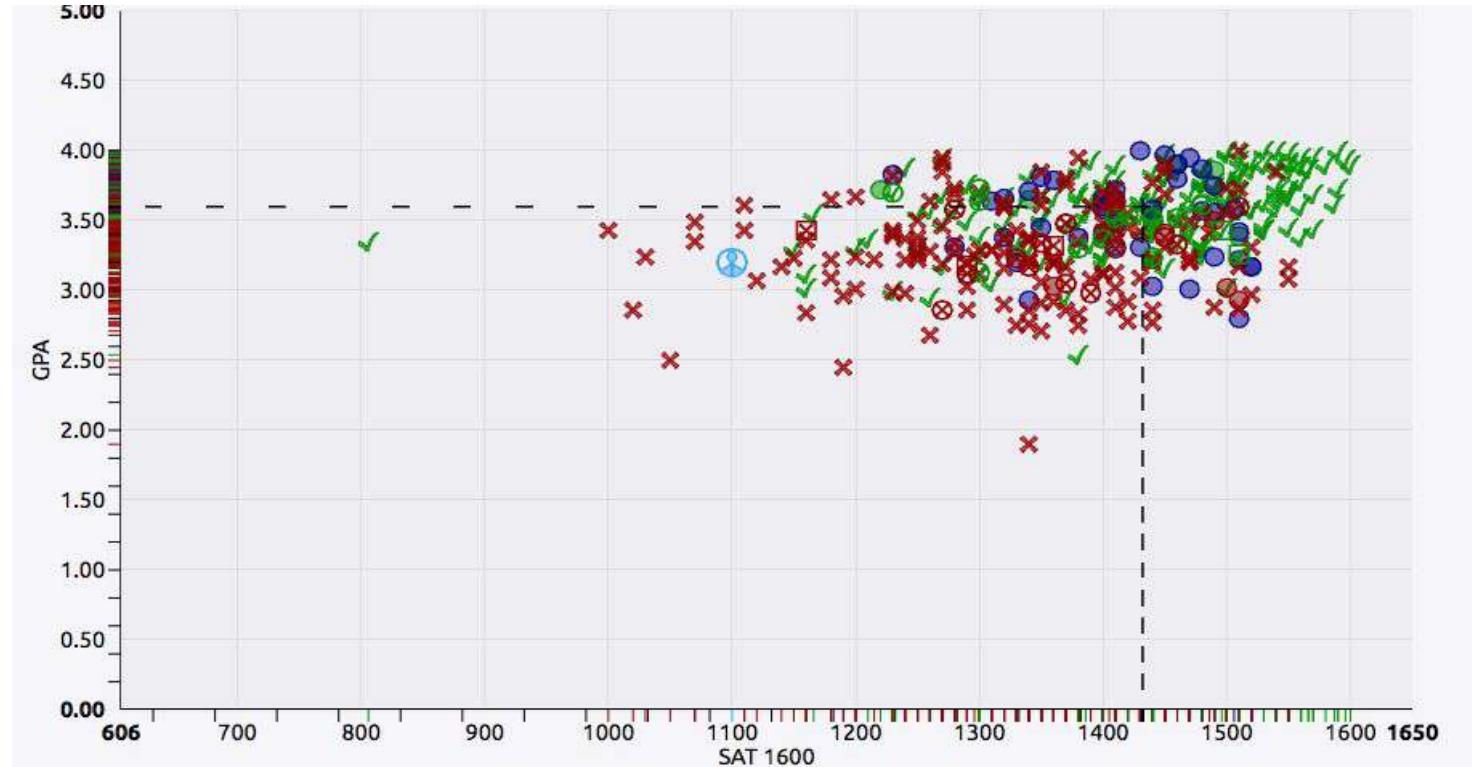
