The alternate model was reviewed by the evaluation committee and approved as an equal substitute. HD Supply provided the bid on the approved substitution and was the lowest bidder. As a result, HD Supply is the lowest and best bidder.

HD Supply provided a bid for an alternate model (All Cleaner XP Advance) but did not provide a demonstration model. Lann Chemical provided a bid for an alternate model (EDIC CR2) and provided a demonstration model. The evaluation committee determined the EDIC CR2 was not an equal substitution because the District specified and needed a compact version that could be used in both small and large square footage areas. During demonstrations, the EDIC CR2 was bulky and could not be used in small square footage areas. Jackson Paper provided a bid for an alternate model (Advance Reel Cleaner) but did not provide a demonstration model. Wheeler's Janitorial Supplies provided the bid on the exact model listed in the specifications. As a result, Wheeler's is the lowest and best bidder.
