Hey, Bobcat Families and Staff! I hope everyone is enjoying this beautiful, sunny Sunday! This past Wednesday and Thursday during ms/hs seminar, teachers took time to present a slidedeck of information to our 6-12th grade students. If for some reason your ms/hs student(s) missed out on this information, it can be viewed on our district website under "Safety" or here. The information covered our cell phone and wireless device policy, disciplinary action for device misuse, gun-free and threat-free schools, consequences of making threats, reporting threats of violence, and the importance of inclusion and connectedness of our fellow classmates. For the inclusion and connectedness learning, students were shown a video from a tv segment from On the Road with Steve Hartman. The video outlines how one high school in Florida created a student club that ensures no student eats alone. At Whiteford, our students are good about making sure no one eats alone, but we challenged our students to consider those students not connected in our classes, especially those students who are new to our district. Sometimes, it is very hard for new students to find their group in a new school, so we are asking our students to step out of their comfort zones and make sure to connect with new students. A daily reminder in the golden rule of "treating others the way you want to be treated" is always good for our students to hear whether that rule applies to in-person or technology driven conversations. We are also asking our students to please report concerns to school staff, the internal "Let Us Know - Whiteford MS/HS" survey found in the students' Schoology account, or the OK2SAY confidential hotline. STUDENT ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL SAFETY

As you may be aware, part of our Bond Series work addresses student and staff arrival and dismissal as we create a new bus loop for dropping off and picking up students. This loop will help alleviate some of our current arrival and dismissal safety concerns with congestion and traffic patterns. Until that work is completed, we are asking families for some help in providing a safer arrival/dismissal process. First, we ask all adults and student drivers to please show kindness, patience, and to be conscious of students or staff walking in the parking lots or crosswalks. Yielding to another vehicle or person is always appreciated in an effort to maintain the safety of all. For arrival, please plan on leaving the house a bit earlier to drop off your child at the school between 7:45-7:55am. At dismissal, our middle/high school students dismiss at 2:55pm, and our student drivers and adults picking up a child are typically leaving the parking lot by 3:00pm. For elementary student pick up, we are asking parents/guardians to please arrive after 3:00pm and closer to 3:10pm to pick up your child. Elementary dismissal is 3:10pm, and having those parents/guardians arrive after 3:00pm will alleviate


congestion in an already limited parking lot. Thank you for helping to be the change and provide a safe environment for our learning community!
