

### Greetings AHS Students and Families,

We hope this welcome back letter finds you relaxing and enjoying summer. We are very excited to see our high school students on Monday, August 28! Enclosed you will find important dates, times, and other relevant information regarding Allendale High School and the 2023-2024 school year. The high school office will open on August 14.

The 2023 - 2024 school year brings a few changes within our staff roster. Mr. Brian Brethauer and Mrs. Laurie Watson retired from education, and Mr. Daniel Russell accepted a job with Royal Oak School District on the east side of the state. Mr. Brethauer served as a science teacher and our head coach of our AHS Science Olympiad team for over three decades at APS. Mrs. Watson also served APS for many years as a building and an athletic department secretary. Mr. Russell served as our Athletic Director for two years. We are happy and excited for Mr. Brethauer, Mrs. Watson, and Mr. Russell to start new chapters in their lives. We wish them the best! I am also pleased to announce new staff members at AHS. We hired a new science teacher to replace Mr. Brethauer, a new athletic secretary to replace Mrs. Watson, and a new athletic director to replace Mr. Russell. We also hired a new general education social worker and an additional English teacher. Ms. Brianna Lee will replace Mr. Brethauer and will teach science classes at AHS. Last year, Ms. Lee completed her student teaching with APS under Mr. Keith Piccard at Allendale Middle School. Mrs. Taylor Evans will replace Mrs. Watson and will serve APS as our new secretary for our Athletic Department and our Athletic Director. We are happy to welcome Mrs. Evans back into APS! Mrs. Evans previously taught Physical Education and Health to our students at Allendale Middle School. Mr. Jason Dykstra will replace Mr. Russell and will serve as our new athletic director. Mr. Dykstra has over 10 years of experience as an athletic director. Mr. Dykstra was also a Physical Education teacher for many years. Mrs. Kelly Koeze is our new general education social worker. Mrs. Koeze has both of her children as students at AHS, and she has over 20 years of social work experience with four of those years completed with Coopersville Public Schools. Mr. Miller Johnson is our additional high school English teacher. He is coming to us from Kenowa Hills Public Schools where he taught middle and high school English and coached JV baseball. We welcome these staff members with excitement and support!

The high school's daily class schedule starts with 1<sup>st</sup> period at 7:45 AM and ends with 6<sup>th</sup> period at 2:33 PM. The high school doors will open at 7:10 AM. We will run a six period school day within a two semester school year. Our first semester at the high school runs from August 28 to January 19, and the second semester runs from January 22 to June 7. <u>Student schedules will be available on hard copies at the high school on August 16 and 17. Student schedules will be shared with students electronically via Infinite Campus' Student Portal on August 18.</u>

We will run a freshman orientation at the high school from 8:45 - 11:45 AM on August 17. This event is an opportunity for 9<sup>th</sup> grade students to become familiar with the building and hear some helpful tips without the stress of 600 other students in the high school. Bus transportation and lunch will be provided on this day. I highly recommend your freshman son or daughter attend this event. The information shared will help reduce the anxiety and stress of joining AHS on the first day of school.

We are also requiring all AHS students\* (freshmen through seniors) to report to the high school on the first day of school. This is different from years past as our Careerline Tech Center students reported to the tech center on the first day of school. This year, we are requiring all students, including tech center students, to report to the high school on August 28. The first day of school is a half day for all APS students. You may remember last year we asked our high school families, students, and staff to vote on acronyms showcasing our values for our new focus on building our positive high school climate and supporting what it means to be a Falcon. We will use this half day to introduce our new Falcon P.R.I.D.E. matrix to our students. Our AHS staff will teach lessons that show our high school students how Falcon P.R.I.D.E. will help establish and support our positive climate.

### P.R.I.D.E. = Persevere Respect Invite Discover and Engage.

This builds the PRIDE in our Falcon P.R.I.D.E. Our AHS students, staff, and administration will strive to show these values in all that we do. We will use this to positively reinforce our high school behavioral expectations while also holding ourselves accountable to our student code of conduct found in our AHS Student Handbook. We are so excited to build and maintain a positive, supportive, and engaging climate that we can all be proud of at AHS!

\*Dual Enrollment and Early College students are not required to attend AHS on the first day of school if their college professors do not give them permission to miss their college classes on the 28th.




# Mr. Miller Johnson - English Teacher
