



2023-2024 Washougal School District Preschool Program Information

Cape Horn-Skye, Columbia River Gorge, and Gause elementary schools all have a preschool program planned for both 3 and 4 year olds starting in the fall of 2023!

This coming year, we're expanding the program to serve students five days per week. Each program will start at the same time as the school, and will run for four hours. The three and four-year old programs will both be in the same classroom. Transportation may be available to school each morning for your child, please inquire when you register.

Our preschool curriculum supports "whole child" instruction with purposeful play, structured activities and hands-on teaching of social/emotional skills, literacy, math, science, physical education, and creative arts. Our teachers provide a depth of experience and commitment to kindergarten readiness in a safe and nurturing environment that recognizes each student's unique abilities. Our intent is to create an environment, which fosters curiosity and creates a love of learning for preschoolers. Children attending our programs must be fully toilet-trained and must behave in such a way that they do not pose harm to self or others.

Preschool Facts:

- Preschool is offered 5 days per week, 4 hours per day
- Fee: \$3,250 annually. Minimum 10 monthly payments of \$325 due monthly September 2023 through June 2024. Payment can be made at the school office or district office with check, credit card, or exact cash. Payments can also be made online:
