#### Student Government and Leadership Code of Conduct and Responsibilities

Students who are voted into office will follow the student government constitution. Here is a brief description of the expectations and responsibilities of a Leadership student at Weddington High School - which is further detailed in the constitution. You will be provided with a detailed copy of the constitution if you are elected onto Student Government. The guidelines provided below are considered minimum standards and students may be asked to take on additional responsibilities as their course work prescribes throughout the year.

As a Student Government Member, it is our expectation that you are a role model to the student body at WHS. Therefore, it is your responsibility to follow the rules and policies of our school and encourage your peers to do so as well. Your role as a student leader will require you to attend and facilitate all Student Government and Class events, speak professionally and conscientiously in front of your peers, faculty, and staff, and attend certain out-of-school events. This position may also require you to direct students, enforce rules, or otherwise help your Leadership teammates; a leader at WHS does so with confidence while demonstrating an overall positive model of behavior at WHS.

Disciplinary actions taken against you throughout the year for attendance, behavior, or honesty infractions could remove you from Student Government. An infraction that involves alcohol, drugs, bullying, cheating and/or assault of any kind will be grounds for dismissal from the position that you may hold.

Your academic success is a critical element of being a role model. We expect that Student Government members are leaders in their classes - by working hard, using integrity, being respectful to those around them, and setting a positive example for others in the class. Being a part of Student Government will require your dedication, initiative, and time. Due to the demands of this program, your ability to manage your time effectively will be important. You will be asked to handle additional responsibilities on behalf of the student body. For example, you have the primary responsibility of planning and executing things such as: Homecoming/Spirit week /Pep Rallies/ Prom/ Special event, ie..send offs for state championship teams. You are required to attend all planning meetings, rehearsals, and events for these activities. You must clear your personal calendar for these weeks to support these activities. You will be there to help set up, execute, and clean up events.
