Information on the Speaker on Human Trafficking on Friday, November 10

Teachers may sign up to bring classes to hear a speaker on human trafficking in the Auditorium on Friday, November 10, at 12:00 p.m. An excerpt on the speaker is included below:

From Chains Interrupted:

The survivor that we have to speak at Linn Mar is a teen. I think that her story will have the greatest impact on your student body and her story will be very relatable to them. I have been speaking with her mom, who said that it will only take her about 20-30 minutes for her to share her story. I was thinking we could start with a speaker explaining what human trafficking is; the force, fraud and coercion components; the laws pertaining to victims who are under 18; the grooming process and where traffickers find people to groom. This would lead to the number one place that people are being groomed into exploitation - the internet. This is where this particular survivor was groomed into trafficking and would lead right into her story. We could then have our speaker follow up with what students can do if they think they or someone they know is being groomed or trafficked.

Signs Of Suicide Lesson During U.S. History Classes on November 15

All 9th grade students will participate in one classroom lesson which teaches them to recognize the signs of depression and suicide in themselves and others. This is a continuation of their learning that took place in the middle school on the signs of suicide. They are taught the appropriate response to these signs is to use the ACT Technique: Acknowledge that there is a problem, let the person know you Care, and Tell a trusted adult. For freshmen enrolled in US History for this semester, their lesson will take place on November 15, 2023. Parents may view the lesson content and tap into valuable resources about suicide at

https://www.mindwise.org/parents/. In January, more communication will be sent on the opportunity for students to complete a Depression Screening. These screenings only occur WITH parent permission and parents will have the opportunity before that time to view the screener that is used.
