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Instructions for 8th Grade Registration Card

Our school day consists of six class periods that meet every day of the week. The school year consists of two 20 week semesters.

*All courses are subject to seat availability.

ACADEMIC COURSES: Every student will be assigned four full year academic classes; US History 8, Science 8, Language Arts, and Math.

* Students who have consistently earned A's in language arts classes and have a passion for reading and strong writing skills may be able to choose Advanced Language Arts 8 for the full year; students may be asked to complete an assessment. Students who have completed Pre-Algebra may select Algebra 1 (please provide documentation).

<u>ELECTIVE COURSES</u> – Students will take 2 full-year electives, <u>OR</u> 1 full-year elective plus 2 semester electives, <u>OR</u> 4 semester electives.

- If your choice is 2 full year electives, please rank/choose the appropriate World Language elective and mark an "X" next to the choice for Music.
- If your choice is 1 full year plus 2 semester electives, rank the 20-week elective classes in order of preference (1-7) and select the appropriate World Language or Music class.
- If your choice is 4 semester electives, please only rank the 20-week elective choices.

 **Please note that students choosing 4 electives cannot be guaranteed their top choices and may be placed in alternative choices based on availability.

<u>WORLD LANGUAGE</u> – Students have the opportunity to take a World Language class in 8th grade, however, it is **not** a required elective in 8th grade. Students who successfully complete a Level 1 language course in 8th grade can take the Level 2 course in high school. Students having successfully completed the Level 1 language course in 7th grade can take Level 2 of that language in 8th grade. **Please provide transcript to show completion of Level 1 high school credit if selecting Level 2.** Students receive a high school credit for passing this course, therefore, the workload, pacing, and expectations reflect the norms of a high school level language course. The grade they receive in this course will be on the high school transcript that goes to colleges. It will not, however, be factored into the high school grade point average (GPA).

<u>MUSIC</u> - Band 8 or Orchestra 8 should only be selected if Band/Orchestra was taken in 7th grade or special arrangements have been made through the instructor. No experience necessary to choose Choir.
