#### **General Tournament Information:**

#### Mission:

It is the mission of The Bellevue Basketball Tournament to provide a fun and safe environment for youth programs. We encourage good sportsmanship, the development of strong playing skills, and the promotion of friendly relationships among the players, coaches, referees, and parents.

#### **Insurance Form:**

Parents must sign a Medical Release Form that holds the tournament and Bellevue Community School district harmless in case of player injuries. It also provides emergency medical information and permission release statements that must be returned to the player's coach before their child will be allowed to play. We will provide the Medical Release Form.

#### **Tournament Dates:**

- October 28-29, 2023
- 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> girls and 3<sup>rd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys play on Saturday, October 28, 2023
- $7^{\text{th}} 8^{\text{th}}$  girls and  $7^{\text{th}} 8^{\text{th}}$  grade boys play on Sunday, October 29, 2023

#### **General Comet Tournament Rules:**

#### **Defense & Pressing**

Zone defense will not be allowed for  $3^{-d} - 5^{+h}$  graders. These grades <u>MUST</u> play Man to Man!  $6^{+h}$ ,  $7^{+h}$ , &  $8^{+h}$  graders will be allowed to play any defense.

Pressing will not be allowed for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> graders!

Pressing will be allowed for  $5^{\circ}$  -  $6^{\circ}$  graders but only in the last 3 minutes of the  $2^{\circ}$  half! However, in the interest of fundamentals and competitive play, pressing will not be allowed if the losing team is down by fifteen (15) or more points throughout the game. Once the lead rises above fifteen (15), the leading team can no longer press.

Pressing will be allowed for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders. However, in the interest of fundamentals and competitive play, pressing will not be allowed if the losing team is down by fifteen (15) or more points throughout the game. Once the lead rises above fifteen (15), the leading team can no longer press.

#### **Free Throws**

- 1 & 1 shots will take place during the 7<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> team fouls of each half
- 2 shots will be awarded after the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul of each half

#### Scorekeeping

Each team/coach shall provide a parent/spectator to serve as the scorekeeper or timekeeper for each game. Both of these individuals must sit at the official's sideline table located at half court during the game.

#### **Technical Fouls:**

Technical fouls can be assessed against a team or any of its members by the game's officials for any number of reasons including unsportsmanlike conduct by players and/or coaches.

Any technical foul assessed against one team will result in the other team being awarded two (2) points and the ball. Coaches and/or players receiving two or more individual technical fouls during the weekend will be automatically ejected for the remainder of the weekend.

#### **Time Limits:**

Each game will consist of two (2), 16-minute halves. All games will be timed using a running clock system, with the clock being stopped only for time-outs and at each whistle during the last two (2) minutes of regulation play and overtime periods of play. There will be a three (3) minute break at halftime. Time will be allotted for a pre-game warm-up but in order to keep the game within the allotted time period, the length of the rest periods may be altered at the discretion of the referees.

If regulation play ends in a tie, an overtime period of two (2) minutes will be allotted. Next two (2) overtimes would consist of one (1) minute periods. If the score still remains tied after the 3<sup>rd</sup> overtime, a sudden death shoot-off will occur with the current players on the floor shooting from the free throw line. Each overtime period will begin with a jump ball.

Game times are approximate. Teams should be ready to play when game ahead finishes. Games may start up to 30 minutes earlier than expected!!

#### Timeouts:

Each team will be allotted two (2) timeouts per game, and one (1) each overtime period if needed. Unused time-outs cannot be carried over. An official's time-out is not charged to either team.

#### Other:

- Rosters must be finalized at the beginning of your 1st game when player liability waivers are collected. NO WAIVER NO PLAY!
- Teams consist of players and up to 2 coaches
- Players may play up, but not down!
- Teams should have two different colored jerseys with numbers
- 3 point goals will not be allowed for 3<sup>rd</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> Grade: All other High School Rules Apply!
- Game Balls: 28.5
