SCHOLARSHIPS*

EPPES-DAVENPORT-MURRELL SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars), will be awarded to several students from Pitt County Public High Schools. ***NOTE:** The students must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

AT-LARGE SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) will be awarded to a student living outside of Pitt County. ***NOTE:** This student must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

RUTH MARIE STATON SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars), will be awarded to a student planning to attend Livingstone College in Salisbury, NC. ***NOTE:** This student must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

CHERRY HESTER COX SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of 500.00 (five hundred dollars), will be awarded to a student planning to attend Pitt Community College. ***NOTE:** This student must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

BENNIE AND JAMESENA MOORE SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars), given to an African American graduating senior in Pitt County or a contiguous county. ***A student known to have received a full scholarship to a college/university is ineligible for this scholarship.***

***NOTE:** This student must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

SALLY CARRAWAY STREETER SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) will be awarded to a current resident of Greenville Housing Authority planning to attend a community college or university.

MR. BULLDOG SCHOLARSHIP, in the amount of \$500 (five hundred dollars), will be awarded to a student planning to attend Pitt Community College in the area of Construction and Industrial Technology (CIT). ***NOTE:** This student must prove close family ties to a person having attended the former Greenville-Industrial or C.M. Eppes High School in Greenville, NC.*

CRITERIA AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES *

In order for a student to apply for the scholarship, he or she must be a candidate for graduation from a Pitt County high school. The Eppes-Davenport-Murrell Scholarship in the amount of \$1000 (one thousand dollars) will be awarded to several students from Pitt County public high schools.

In addition an at-large recipient having close family ties to an alumnus of Greenville Industrial/Eppes High School will be chosen to receive a \$1,000 (one thousand dollar scholarship. This recipient will be a candidate for graduation from a high school outside of the Pitt County area.

Applicants must be a candidate for graduation and must have the endorsement of his or her high school principal. Candidates should also have a scholastic average of 2.5 or better and meet all requirements for college entrance.

The student must personally be responsible for submitting his/her application to the Eppes Scholarship Committee. Each applicant must include with the application the following information:

- 1. An official 3 x 5 non-returnable school photo.**
- 2. Essay as specified on the checklist.**
- 3. A Letter of Recommendation from the high school representative (administrator, teacher or advisor/counselor).**
- 4. The following from your school office: his/her high school transcript, college entrance grades (SAT or ACT) both verbal and math, rank in senior class and the number of members in the class.**
- 5. The signature of parents or guardians.**

Checklist of Required Items

- ___ Completed scholarship application form
- ___ Essay (one page, typed, minimum of 500 words or 3 -5 minute video). See essay prompt below:
Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
- ___ Recent 3x5 non-returnable school photo (via email or mail)
- ___ Letter of recommendation in a sealed envelope from a teacher, counselor, school administrator or other qualified individual who knows you well, but is not a relative
- ___ Recent official high school transcript including SAT/ACT scores, GPA, rank, and anticipated date of graduation
- ___ The completed application packet must be emailed or postmarked by *Sunday, April 30, 2023. See below.*
