2023 Mathematics Summer School Focus

Kindergarten	Understand addition as putting together and adding to, and understand subtraction as taking apart and taking from. Work with numbers 11–19 to gain foundations for place value.
1st Grade	Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction. Understand and apply properties of operations and the relationship between addition and subtraction.
2nd Grade	Understand place value. Use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract.
3rd Grade	Represent and solve problems involving multiplication and division. Understand properties of multiplication and the relationship between multiplication and division.



2023 Mathematics Summer School Focus

4th Grade	Extend understanding of fraction equivalence and ordering. Build fractions from unit fractions by applying and extending previous understandings of operations on whole numbers.
5th Grade	Perform operations with multi-digit whole numbers and with decimals to hundredths. Use equivalent fractions as a strategy to add and subtract fractions.
6th - 8th Grade Agile Mind AYD	<p>Understand ratio concepts and use ratio reasoning to solve problems. Solve real-life and mathematical problems using numerical and algebraic expressions and equations. Understand the connections between proportional relationships, lines, and linear equations.</p> <p>SEL Competencies: self-awareness, self-management, social relationships</p>



2023 ELA Summer School Focus

Kindergarten	Letter identification, letter-sound identification, writing
1st Grade	Ask and answer questions about text, phonics skills, and writing to answer questions
2nd/3rd Grade	Ask and answer questions about text, phonics skills, and writing to answer questions
4th Grade	Use text evidence to make inferences about the text, read with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension, draw evidence from text for purpose of research, reflection, and analysis
5th Grade	Use text evidence to make inferences about the text, read with accuracy and fluency to support comprehension, draw evidence from text for purpose of research, reflection, and analysis
6th - 8th Grade	Use text evidence to make inferences about the text, gather information from multiple print and digital sources.
