A Typical School Day...

- **Six Class Periods:** Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies with 2 Exploratory Classes
- **8:05-3:08pm (2:08 on Thursdays) with Lunch:** Doors open at 7:50am and lunch is between 3rd & 4th hours (~11:30am)
- **Lockers:** Backpacks, coats, large items are stored in the locker all day. Lockers are located near their team's core classrooms for quick access in A House.
- **A / B Team:** Core classroom teachers share the same group of students.

S.A.F.E. - Students and Family Engagement: SAFE members work with students individually and in small groups to support various social emotional needs along with supporting families with getting resources.

Honors Health Behavior Clinician: Melonie Hobbs is our on-site mental health therapist that can provide 1:1 and group support to our students and families.

District Nurse: Malory Robak serves all of our buildings to support medical plans of care for students.

Safety & Security Team: Eugene Davis is our safety coordinator and works with our hall monitors, administrators, noon attendants, and school resource officer to ensure that our building remains safe.

School Resource Officer: Officer Kelly Johnson serves as a mentor for students and works with administrators to ensure that our building remains safe.

Office Team: Roxanne Furlong, Missi Long, and Donna Phillips support the daily hustle and bustle of our school along with assisting students and families.

Building Guest Teachers: Kim Heckman, Nicole Hudson, Karen Rudzinski serve as substitutes placed into classrooms or other roles throughout the building as needed. This allows us to provide consistent and continuous supports to our students.

- Review ways to stay organized between home and school - One tool provided is a daily planner for each student
