## BELL ACADEMY UNIFIED DRESS CODE 2024-2025

The following uniforms may be worn for all Bell Academy students. Bell Academy uniforms may be found at Looking Good, Wal-Mart, and other vendors of the parents' choice.

### Shirts

navy blue, light blue, light yellow, white

### Shorts & Pants

navy blue, khaki

### Skirts

navy blue, khaki, plaid with yellow pin stripe

### Dresses

navy blue, light blue, khaki, plaid with yellow pin stripe

### Leggings

white, navy blue, black

Leggings may be worn under skirts and dresses.

### Shoes

Shoes must have a closed heel or a back strap. Tennis shoes must be worn on the day the student attends P.E. Crocs and flip flops are not to be worn.

On Fridays, students may wear their uniform or blue jeans with a Bell Academy shirt. The last Friday of each month is free dress day. The students may wear their choice of clothing, however it must follow the Cleveland School District dress code policy.

## Cleveland School District Dress Code

Dress Code Regulations Students who attend schools with uniform dress code must adhere to that school's uniform requirements and rules, as well as adhering to district dress code regulations. Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. Any extreme form of dress which is distracting to the teaching-learning process is prohibited.

Administrators will determine the appropriateness and inappropriateness of dress. Students will not be allowed to wear any type of jewelry during their PE class that may result in injury to the student. The CSD will not be responsible for items that may be lost or stolen while students are involved in any activities. The principal shall have the final decision about the appropriateness of the clothing for school.

The dress code will be enforced by all Bell Academy personnel. A notice will be issued by the teacher or office personnel if guidelines are not met. Serious infractions may require a change in dress. Multiple infractions (3 or more) will result in a detention. Detention is held each Thursday from 3:00-4:00.
