**VOTER REGISTRATION:** You may register in the office of the district clerk, located within the Administration Building at 7 Memorial Drive in Miller Place, Monday through Friday (excluding holidays) between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Registration is for new residents or those residents who have not voted in the district or Suffolk County election in the past four years. Proof of residency is required. The deadline to register to vote at the Administration Building is May 16, 2024, at 3:00 p.m. If you would like to register after May 16, 2024 for the May 21, 2024 budget vote, you must do so through the Board of Elections in Yaphank.

**VOTER ELIGIBILITY:** You must be a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age or older on the day of the vote, and a resident of the Miller Place School District for at least 30 days prior to May 21, 2024.

**ABSENTEE/EARLY MAIL BALLOTS:** Applications for absentee and early mail ballots may be obtained through the office of the district clerk and the district website. Applications must be filed by May 15, 2024, if the ballot is to be mailed, or by May 20, 2024, if the ballot is personally given to the voter.
