STUDENT CHROMEBOOKS

1:1 Device Program Forms - Chromebooks and chargers can be picked up during the Welcome Back Night or on the first day of school. In order to receive your device, the Pledge Form and Optional Insurance Form MUST be completed. Optional insurance is available to purchase at \$45.00 per student. This covers one accidentally break for the current school year.

A fully charged Chromebook is required for each school day, including the first day of school.

MANDATORY ANNUALUPDATE

Student safety is extremely important to us. To ensure their information is accurate, we are requesting 1 parent/guardian to login and verify each child's information.

- Household information address and phone numbers
- Parent information work and cell phone numbers, email addresses
- Student information demographic and health/medication information
- Emergency Contact addresses and phone numbers

The Annual Update will include all of the required parent/guardian approvals of handbooks, field trips, photographs, etc.

INFINITE CAMPUS PORTAL

The Infinite Campus portal is your tool to stay connected to your student's education. If you have not taken the time to set up your Parent Portal, please contact the office & we can assist you in setting that up. You should be using your own portal, not your students. As parents, you may receive different notifications & messages than your child will. To access Infinite Campus from a computer, follow this path:

Byron Public Schools > Families > Infinite Campus > Campus Parent>Enter your username & password

To access Infinite Campus on a tablet or smartphone you will need to download the Infinite Campus app, then enter our District ID, which is **XJLZDW**.

BHS STUDENT PARKING PASS

Beginning this year, students who choose to drive to school will be required to purchase a BHS Student Parking Pass. The cost of this pass is \$75 for the year (students taking two classes or less, or only attending one semester at BHS this year, will pay \$35).

It is a privilege to drive and park on the Byron High School Campus. You will be expected to read and understand all driving/parking rules for the campus. Any violation of parking lot rules may result in disciplinary actions through Administration, ticketing, loss of parking permit, or towed vehicle at owner's expense. All motorized vehicles will be subject to the full provisions of the following rules and applicable state laws.

- 1. All vehicles must be registered and display a **CURRENT** BHS Parking Permit on the driver's side dash with the permit number clearly visible.
- 2. The registered driver is responsible for the behavior of others in their vehicle, even if they are not present.
- 3. Motorized vehicles should be parked in the student parking lot in designated parking spaces within the lines. Vehicles parked in fire lanes, handicap zones, off-limit areas, or blocking traffic may be tagged by police and/or towed at the owner's expense. Off-limit areas include all areas outside the student parking lot, including staff and visitor spots.
- 4. All TRAFFIC LAWS are enforced. Exhibition driving (squealing tires, skidding, etc.) is prohibited.
- 5. Driving on sidewalks, lawns, or athletic fields is prohibited. Drivers are required to pay restitution and may be subject to disciplinary actions through the Administration.
- 6. Drivers should report accidents, vandalism, or theft to the Administration or Police immediately.

***NOTE**: Byron High School permits are the property of BHS and are valid on-campus only, not for surrounding streets around campus.

To purchase a BHS Student Parking Pass for the 2024-2025 year, click on the link below to complete the form. Parking Passes can be picked up at Welcome Back Night on August 20th or after that night passes will be available in the high school office.

BHS FLEX FRIDAYS

Flex Fridays are school days. They are not days off. Flex Fridays are used for the purpose of providing students intervention time with their teachers and enrichment opportunities that take place inside and outside of school. Students could be invited by one or more of their teachers to come into the school in order to get intervention time and enrichment opportunities BUT any student that would like to come in and meet with their teachers on that day are more than welcome! We will follow a regular school day schedule so for instance, if the student wants to visit with their 2nd block teacher they would need to come in during that time frame. If your student was not invited nor voluntarily wants to come in on a Flex Friday, they do not have to report to school.

FLU VACCINE CLINIC - SEPTEMBER 16

A flu clinic will be held on Monday, September 16th. Registration is required and will only be available from August 7–September 11 at 11:00 p.m. No late registrations will be accepted.

The flu vaccine will be offered at your child's school through the School-Located Influenza Program this fall. This program makes it

easy and convenient to keep your child, the school, and the community healthy throughout the year.



Important information to know:

- The flu shot and nasal spray (FluMist®) will be offered as available.
- Registration is required to receive the flu vaccine.
- Registration forms will not be accepted after September 11.
- Non-medication pain-reducing options will be available.
- Health insurance will be billed. If you don't have health insurance, your child can still get the flu vaccine at little or no cost.
- Provide a reminder to your child the day before receiving the flu vaccine and have them wear clothing that allows access to the upper arm.
