



Too many absences—excused or unexcused—can keep students from succeeding in school and in life. How many are too many? 10% of the school year—that's 18 missed days or 2 days a month—can knock students off track.

ALL ABSENCES counts towards total # of absences

The following information can be found in the Parent Handbook

#### Excused Absences

- A. Illness
- B. Death in the family
- C. Critical family illness
- D. Court summons
- E Work; study, exams or school related service with prior approval
- F. Observance of a religious holiday

- G. State emergency
- H. Snow day/impassable roadways as declared by the school district or other governmental municipality
- I. Suspension
- J. Approved college visits
- K. Health care appointments that cannot be scheduled outside the school day

Please note: Any excused absence will still count as an absence from school, as required by NY State.

All other absences, tardiness, and early departures will be considered unexcused absences and must be accounted for under our Attendance Policy. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the school office on the next school day of the absences, tardiness, and early departures, and to provide a written excuse upon the student's return to school.

#### All absent notes need to include:

- 1. Student name
- 2. Date of absence(s)
- 3. Reason for absence
- Legible parent signature

#### NEW YORK LAW

# THE DIGNITY ACT

THE DIGNITY FOR ALL STUDENTS ACT

NO STUDENT SHALL BE SUBJECTED TO BULLYING, DISCRIMINATION, HARASSMENT, OR CYBERBULLYING BASED ON THE STUDENT'S ACTUAL OR PERCEIVED:

- RACE
- WEIGHT
- Color
- NATIONAL ORIGIN
- ETHNIC GROUP
- RELIGION

- RELIGIOUS PRACTICES
- DISABILITY
- SEXUAL ORIENTATION
- GENDER: INCLUDING GENDER
  IDENTITY AND EXPRESSION
- Sex
- Other

This act applies to incidents on school property and school sponsored functions. Also, acts occurring off ground that could disrupt the school environment.



#### WHAT HAPPENS WHEN BULLYING IS REPORTED?

- 1. Incidents of bullying or harassment should be reported to school staff member immediately: Teacher, Staff Assistant, Bus Driver, Administrator, Counselor, Social Worker
- 2. STAFF MEMBERS WILL COMPLETE AN OFFICE DISCIPLINE REFERRAL (ODR) AND TURNS IT INTO A BUILDING ADMINISTRATOR
- 3. ADMINISTRATION WILL REVIEW THE REPORT AND REFERS CASE TO A DIGNITY ACT COORDINATOR WHEN APPLICABLE
- 4. THE DAC WILL COMPLETE A THOROUGH INVESTIGATION BY TALKING WITH ALL THE STUDENTS INVOLVED
- 5. THE DAC, ALONG WITH AN ADMINISTRATOR, WILL DETERMINE IF THE REPORT IS EITHER FOUNDED OR UNFOUNDED
- 6. DEPENDING ON THE RESULTS, STUDENTS ARE SUPPORTED BY THE WELLNESS TEAM, AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION NECESSARY ALONG WITH PARENT CONTACT ARE MADE




