- Richard Avedon (1923-2004) Iconic fashion and portrait photographer known for his work in Harper's Bazaar and Vogue.
- **Irving Penn (1917-2009)** Renowned for his innovative and meticulous approach to fashion photography.
- **Annie Leibovitz** Acclaimed portrait photographer who has also made significant contributions to fashion photography.
- **Peter Lindbergh** German photographer who photographs supermodels
- Mario Testino fashion and portrait photographer who has photographed many supermodels for Voque
- Barry Feinstein (1931-2011) iconic photographs of 1960s rock and folk musicians, including Bob Dylan and George Harrison
- **Eve Arnold** candid portraits of celebrities like Marilyn Monroe, social and political issues, including civil rights and women's rights.
- **David Bailey** British fashion and portrait photographer famous for his work in the 1960s, capturing striking and stylish images of celebrities, models, and cultural icons

Portraiture Photographers:

- **Diane Arbus (1923-1971)** Known for her unconventional and often controversial portraits of marginalized individuals.
- Yousuf Karsh (1908-2002) Master portrait photographer, famous for capturing iconic figures of the 20th century.
- **Platon Antoniou (Platon)** Contemporary portrait photographer, known for capturing political and cultural figures.

- Manuel Alvarez Bravo Mexican street photographer
- **Robert Frank** raw and unvarnished view of American life in the 1950s, challenging traditional notions of photography with his candid and often gritty style.
- **Joel Meyerowitz** spontaneous moments on the streets, and his later work documenting the aftermath of 9/11 at Ground Zero

Skateboarding Photographers:

- **J. Grant Brittain -** celebrated for his iconic images that documented the rise of skate culture in the 1980s and 1990s
- C. R. Stecyk III- early skateboarding and surf scenes in Southern California, particularly through his work with the *Dogtown* crew
- **Skin Phillips-** legendary British skateboarding photographer, recognized for his decades-long work capturing skateboarding's evolution, both in Europe and the U.S
- Ed Templeton- professional skateboarder, artist, and photographer known for his raw and personal street photography that often explores youth culture, skateboarding, and suburban life

- Ansel Adams- (1902-1984) Master of black-and-white landscape photography, especially in the American West. (this would require you to travel to Yosemite.)
- Michael Kenna Known for his minimalist and ethereal black-and-white landscape images.
- Edward Burtynsky Focuses on industrial landscapes and environmental impact in his photography.
- **Charlie Waite** British landscape photographer known for tranquil and evocative compositions.

- Clark Little Captures breathtaking shorebreak waves and surf culture.
- Brian Bielmann Renowned surf photographer, capturing powerful and dramatic surf scenes.
