5. A short letter of endorsement (300 words or less) from your music teacher. This letter should address talent, diligence, responsibility, musical growth and accomplishment.

The criteria for this award include musical talent and proficiency, involvement in school and/or community performance groups, the short essay, and letters of endorsement. The organization reserves the right to determine the disposition of the award. The recipient of the award will be invited to participate as a soloist in a future Pine Hill Singers' concert.
