2024 PIRANDELLO SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Pirandello Lyceum is an organization that aims to maintain and share Italian culture and language in America Its various programs reflect significant accomplishments of Italian thinkers in the areas of art, science, culture, and humanitarianism. Established by a group of professionals from the academic and business communities in Massachusetts, its activities have been recognized with support from the Massachusetts Council of the Arts and Humanities, the Massachusetts Foundation for the Humanities and Public Policy, and private contributors. It is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization.

Each year the Pirandello Lyceum offers several scholarships to outstanding High School Students who have studied Latin, Italian or another foreign language in High School and/or who plan to study Italian Language and/or Culture in College. Pirandello Scholar applicants must have:

- High academic average
- · Studied a foreign language in High School, preferably Italian and/or Latin
- High SAT scores
- Intend to study Italian Language and/or Italian Culture in college and/or intend to spend a semester abroad in Italy
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- · Personal and/or family involvement in Italian Community
- Scholarship Recipient must be present at MAY 19, 2024, Scholarship Ceremony to receive scholarship funds

Requirements for Application

- High School Transcript
- Copy of SAT Scores
- A completed application form that is accompanying this notice or visit http://pirandello.com/pirandello-scholarship-program/)
- Two Letters of Recommendation from High School Teachers (preferably one from an Italian / Latin Language Teacher)
- A single page essay on why you are deserving of this scholarship and the importance of Italian culture in your life. Note: Applicants should explain specifics of financial need, if applicable.
- DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION: POSTMARKED BY APRIL 15, 2024
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted by the Scholarship Committee.
