



THE 2024 ROBERT E. EDWARDS SCHOLARSHIP

In gratitude for the many years of service that Mr. Edwards has given to our community, a scholarship fund has been established in his name to benefit students from our area in their education. The goal of the scholarship is to honor Mr. Edwards' lifetime contribution to our community and to continue his legacy. It will be administered by Worthington American Legion Post #828 (WALMP 828).

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:

The Robert E. Edwards Scholarship is a nonrenewable gift. Based on applications received and monies on hand, and divided equally between high school and college applicants; at a minimum, there will be awarded one each \$1,000 first place and \$800 second place for both graduating high school and current college awardees. Awardees or their approved representative are required to attend and accept the scholarship at our scheduled meeting in July.

This applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior or a current college student
- Be a current resident of Worthington Borough/West Franklin Township OR daughter, son, grandchild/great grandchild of a current WALMP 828 active member or a deceased member who was in good standing at the time of their passing.
- Be accepted at an accredited college or university, trade or technical school, attending in the fall of the coming school year.

All applicants must complete the scholarship application and complete the following essay question:

Please write a personal statement of no more than two pages explaining what freedom means to you. How does it relate to other values, such as justice, equality and democracy?
