WV Learns Summer Virtual

- **Beginning May 1st:** A student must discuss summer virtual course requests with his/her counselor, have the course recorded on his/her Personalized Education Plan by the counselor, and finally complete a registration form (provided by counselor) to be submitted along with payment to Dr. Epling.
- Each ½ credit costs 75.00. Please write checks to GWHS.
- Registration requests will only be submitted after payment has been received. The last day to register is **June 7th**.

Access to WV Learns Virtual Courses begins on May 31st and will close on July 31, 2024. All submitted work will be graded, and the grade will be transcribed. There are **no exceptions** to permit an extension of time. This is a high school course, whereas **the grade will be a part of the student's high school transcript and overall GPA** regardless if they do not complete the course. Parents have a one-week grace period to remove their child without a grade being recorded on the student's permanent record. After this, the course will remain, and the final grade will be transcribed. The payment for the course is **non-refundable**.
