Mission: To honor Deena L. Woods by funding scholarships for deserving high school graduates who desire to make a difference in the world through the teaching profession, preferably with a focus in Early Childhood Education. Deena is a 1982 graduate of White Oak High School and a 1987 graduate of East Carolina University. She taught elementary school for thirty years in Onslow County (NC), Wake County (NC), and Prince William County (VA). Teaching was her passion, and everyone that knew her, worked with her, or was fortunate enough to be taught by her knew she genuinely cared for and loved each and every one of them. She referred to her students as "my babies", loving them, motivating them, disciplining them, caring for them, and teaching them. She taught more than academic lessons, she taught the life skills and traits which she embodied: compassion, friendship, empathy, cooperation, respect, being courteous, and love. She will be sorely missed by her family, colleagues, former students, parents, and friends.

The Deena L. Woods Memorial Teaching Scholarship is designed to assist deserving high school graduates who have been a pillar in their high school and community, as demonstrated by their outstanding academic achievement, leadership, and compassion for their community. The Deena L Woods Memorial Teaching Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of at least \$3,900. With 2025 being our sixth year, we are accepting applications from 2025 high school graduates of White Oak High School, Jacksonville High School, and Northside High School.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Must be accepted to a school of higher education, pursuing a curriculum for a Teaching/Education degree, preferably in the area of Early Childhood Education.
- 2. Must be graduating from high school during the year applying for this scholarship.
- 3. Must have a 3.0 weighted GPA or higher and submit an official transcript with the application.
- 4. Must submit a copy of the acceptance letter from the accredited college or university with the application.
- 5. Must have three (3) letters of recommendation submitted from references: Two (2) of the letters must be from a recent (within the last 3 years) teacher or other education related personnel (i.e., Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, etc.). The third letter can be from whomever you choose (i.e., coach, employer, family friend, neighbor, additional teacher, etc.). Ensure your references know to mail their letter of recommendation by April 25th.
- Must complete all requirements of the application, and all application forms must be received (postmarked) by April 25^h.
- 7. Finalists for consideration will be notified by May 10th at which time a **brief in-person interview** with the Finalists will be scheduled with the Scholarship Committee.
