

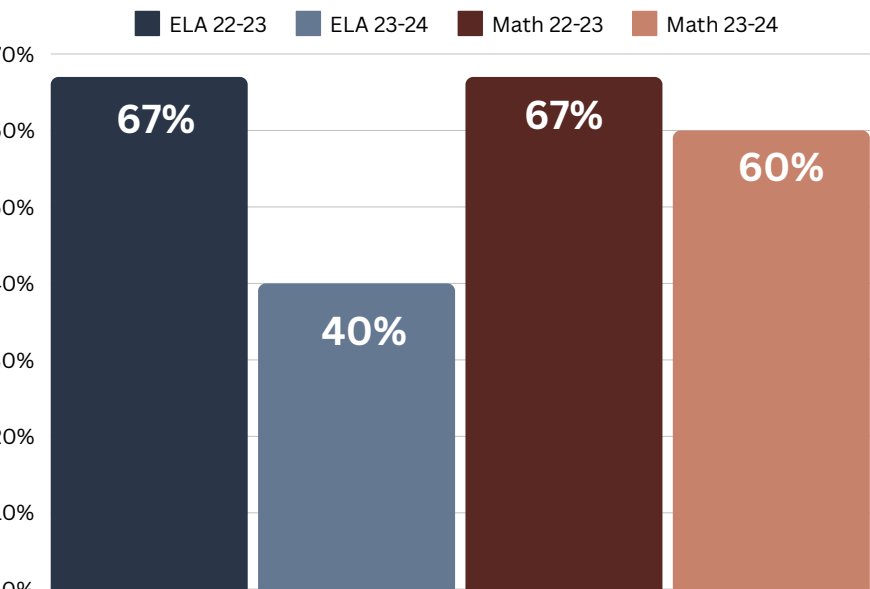


ANDERSON ISLAND ELEMENTARY CONTINUOUS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 2023-2026

Goal 1

80% of K-3 students will demonstrate individual growth in the areas of Phonological Awareness, Phonics and High-Frequency Words as demonstrated on i-Ready assessments

Action Steps:

- Students will look at and interpret their scores with the teacher throughout the year
- Students will complete weekly i-Ready lessons tailored to their individual skill levels
- Teachers will individualize instruction through i-Ready assignments and work with each student to show growth through the year

Goal 2

80% of K-3 students will demonstrate individual growth in the areas of Numbers & Operations, and Algebra & Algebraic Equations as demonstrated on i-Ready assessments

Action Steps:

- Students will look at and interpret their scores with the teacher throughout the year
- Students will complete weekly i-Ready lessons tailored to their individual skill levels
- Staff will deliver instruction through diverse formats, including whole group, small group, one-on-one, and i-Ready Individual Learning Paths, to address students' instructional needs
- All our staff will participate in ongoing, specially designed professional development from Ready Math throughout the year to enhance instructional strategies and better support student learning

Goal 3

Students will work toward more consistent attendance

Action Steps:

- All Staff will work to create positive relationships with their students and their families
- AIE will send home monthly attendance snapshots to families of their student's attendance
- AIE will implement a positive reinforcement program where students with improved or perfect attendance each month receive recognition and rewards, such as certificates, small prizes, or special privileges (e.g., extra recess time or a 'student of the month' highlight). Staff will track attendance improvements and celebrate students' efforts during classroom meetings
