#### **Learning Priorities and Considerations**

- The primary tools for communication between the teacher and families will be SeeSaw, email,
   Google Meet and by phone
- · The classroom teacher will assign work daily
- Students will have both off- and on-screen learning activities designed to engage learners in experiences that connect to the current curriculum and to the real world

- · Complete assignments with integrity and academic honesty, doing your best work
- Parents please allow your student to do their own work and only guide them when needed
- Do your best to meet timelines and due dates
- Use classroom ipad for Distance Learning assignments and activities only
- Communicate proactively with your teacher if you cannot meet deadlines or require additional support
- Ensure the student is ready to start Distance Learning on March 30<sup>th</sup> by logging into and exploring the resources listed below

  - Login to Seesaw (app on classroom ipad) and familiarize yourself with its features
  - Login to IXL (app on classroom ipad)
  - Login to Epic (app on classroom ipad)
  - Create Google Meet account
  - Login to Scholastic News
  - Login to Science Spin
