 - a. Column 1 Heading (Variable)- Months
 - b. Column 2 Heading (Variable) Temperature of Voorhees
 - c. Column 3 Heading (Variable) Temperature of Seattle
 - d. Enter data (temperature) for six months
- 3. Save database as Comparing the climate of two cities
- 4. Create bar graph with Graph Master of Voorhees, NJ over six months
 - a. Select graph
 - b. Place a check next to month and Voorhees and click OK
 - c. Select bar graph
 - d. Type maximum length as 100 and step size as 5 and click OK
 - e. Click on Title and type Voorhees
 - f. Save as Weather in Voorhees over six months
- Create bar graph with Graph Master of Seattle, WA over six months.
 - a. Select graph
 - b. Place a check next to month and Seattle and click OK
 - c. Select bar graph
 - d. Type maximum length as 100 and step size as 5 and click OK
 - e. Click on Title and type Seattle

- f. Save as Weather in Seattle over six months
- 6. Create bar graph comparing Voorhees, NJ and Seattle, WA over six months
 - a. Select graph
 - b. Place a check next to month, Voorhees, and Seattle and click OK
 - c. Select bar graph
 - d. Type maximum length as 100 and step size as 5 and click OK
 - e. Click on Title and type Comparing Climates of Voorhees and Seattle
 - f. Save as Comparing the Climates over six months
