- Log into the Chromebook
  - username = StudentID@student.cms.k12.nc.us
  - password = your chrome password
- Once you enter the first website, you will encounter filtering process. Type in your:
  - username = StudentID@cms.k12.nc.us
- Last screen of credentials, type in your:
  - username = StudentID@cms.k12.nc.us
  - password = YYYYMMDD (8 digit birthdate) (If this password doesn't work please use the password your teacher gave you before you left school and if you are unsure of the password please contact your teacher)

#### How do Laccess Canvas?

1. Go to the CMS website. Click on the "Students" icon (student with backpack).




3. You can now click the red circle "Canvas" icon. This is the same icon Your child will see when they log into NCEdCloud (Rapid Identity).
