Literacy Assessments, Grades K-4

Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessment: This one-on-one assessment measures the level of difficulty at which a student is able to read fiction and non-fiction texts through word accuracy and comprehension. It is administered to each student in fall and spring. The benchmark, or target score has been determined by the assessment scale of grade level expectation and evaluation of the district trend data identifying the score needed to be on track for reading success.

DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills: The brief oral reading assessment measures the development of early literacy skills. This short fluency measure identifies a key indicator of early reading skills and can be used to monitor progress in fluency. Each student is assessed individual using the DIBELS oral reading fluency protocols. Kindergarten students are assessed on phone segmentation fluency. The benchmark, or target score has been determined by the assessment scale of grade level expectation and evaluation of district trend date identifying the score needed to be on track for reading success.

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) RIT Scores, Grades 3-11

Utilizing research conducted by Technology and Information Education Services (TIES) and Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA), a series of benchmark target scores were developed through a linking study as a means to determine if students in grades 3 thru 11 are meeting state academic standards while attaining career and college readiness. As a result of their research, TIES and NWEA were able to determine the levels of performance that are needed at multiple points in time to predict the desired outcomes (attainment of college-readiness benchmarks on the ACT). A description of the benchmark target scores is provided below.
