- B. Invertebrate (has no back bone) or Vertebrate (has back bone)
- C. Description: What does it look like? (fur, scales, color, type of beak, etc.)
- D. Is it warm blooded or cold blooded?
- E. What is its life span?
- F. Where does your animal live/ Habitat?
- G. Any interesting facts that you learned about your animal.
