SCIENCE: Last week in Science, students completed and presented their projects on the Engineering Design Process. Students did an excellent job with their builds and learned what is necessary to complete the engineer design process. To see their work please look on ClassDojo. This week, students will begin a Unit on Energy with a look at Force and Motion. Throughout this unit they will complete many hands on labs that will allow them to experience first hand what the concepts are about. They will be getting a science book/workbook.
