

Fourth Grade Supply List
Emma B. Ward Elementary School

Each student will need the following items:

- 2 packages wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 **spiral bound graph** notebook **100 sheets 4x4 quad** – available at Walmart or if you can find it cheaper (for Science class)
- 4 packages pencils – **no mechanical pencils**
- 3 containers Clorox wipes (2 will be used for Science class)
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 Two-pack black Dry Erase markers (for Math class)
- 1 **BLACK only** 1-inch 3 ring binder **must have a clear overlay on front**(will be used in Math class only-dividers will be provided by math teacher)
- 1 black marble composition book (for Language Arts class)
- 2 1-inch 3 ring binders any color **must have a clear overlay on front** (will be used in Language arts classes)
- 1 3x3-inch package of Post-it notes (will be used in all classes)
- 1 3x5 inch package of Post-it-notes (will be used in all classes)
- 1 ½ to 2 inch – **three ring zippered binder** (any design or color)*
- 5 – **three hole punch folders** (any design or color)*

Optional:

- 1 bottle hand sanitizer for classroom use
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 box **latex free** band aids
- 1 box washable markers

Important Notes:

1. All students will have 1 cubby (14 inches wide and 23 inches high) to store a backpack and binder, a jacket or winter coat, and a lunch box if brought. Please plan these purchases according to this size cubby.
2. All student possessions must fit in this cubby and cannot be placed on the floor or left hanging out of the cubby due to safety standards.
3. All binders must fit in the desk cubby during class time, especially during Science class to allow for the use of scientific tools during class, due to safety standards.

Electronic Devices

Students will be allowed to bring iPhones, iPods, iPads, Kindles, Nooks, Notebooks, etc for instructional use only. Students will use these devices regularly in Science class. Larger screens such as an iPad or iPad mini allow students to do more work easier.
